This audition will be conducted in two parts: (a) an initial screening and selection by pre-recorded audio files, and (b) a live audition for those selected from the initial screening. Details concerning both the audio file submission and the live audition are attached. Please look over these requirements carefully to determine if you are prepared to take the audition at this time.

The following information outlines requirements and important dates:

| April 8, 2016 | Deadline for receipt of all musical pre-screening materials (Demonstration CDs cannot be returned to applicant). |
| April 15, 2016 | Each candidate will be notified whether or not he/she is found musically qualified to participate in the live audition. |
| May 23, 2016 | Live audition at Scott Air Force Base, IL |

In addition to passing the musical audition, you must also meet other criteria in order to become a member of an Air Force Band. Before applying, carefully determine if you feel you meet the following Air Force eligibility requirements.

| Age: | You must be able to enlist in the Air Force PRIOR to your 39 th birthday. |
| Weight: | Overweight individuals are prohibited from enlisting in the Air Force. A weight scale according to height is attached. |
| Medical: | Individuals must be qualified for worldwide duty. Chronic medical problems, congenital defects, etc., may be disqualifying factors. |
| Financial: | A severe financial problem could be a disqualifying factor. |
| Criminal: | A criminal record could be a disqualifying factor. |
| Citizenship: | You must be a natural born citizen, naturalized, or able to complete the naturalization process within four years. |

STRING/ELECTRIC BASS PRE-SCREENING REQUIREMENTS

1) Résumé

2) Audio recordings demonstrating musical & stylistic versatility on string and electric bass including:

- A) **String Bass Solo/Etude:** Perform one of the following works (or a work of similar difficulty):
 - a. *Eccles*: Sonata in G Minor
 - b. *Simandj*: Etude in E Minor

- B) **Jazz:** Perform appropriate bass line and solo with a jazz ensemble and/or 3-6 member combo in the following categories. Either electric or double bass may be used, but at least one piece must be played on each instrument.
 - a. Bossa Nova
 - b. Swing
 - c. Bebop

- C) **Popular Music:** Perform appropriate bass line and solo with a popular music ensemble in the following categories. Either electric or double bass may be used, but at least one piece must be played on each instrument.
 - a. Rock
 - b. Pop/R&B
 - c. Country
 - d. Funk

It is preferred that the recordings include accompaniment by live musicians, or with “music minus one” style tracks. It is acceptable to include solo performances for some of the above styles, but please include as many group performances as possible.

All résumés and pre-screening materials must be received by April 8th, 2016

Each candidate will be notified of results by April 15, 2016. Live audition is by invitation only.
