The Concert Band is comprised of 44 musicians and is the largest performing ensemble within the United States Air Force Band of the Golden West. The band has performed for thousands of listeners in live concert appearances and for millions worldwide via recordings, television and radio broadcasts. Throughout its history, the Concert Band has collaborated with some of America's leading soloists and band conductors, receiving enthusiastic critical acclaim as one of the premier musical organizations of its kind. The Concert Band

performs a wide variety of music, including standard concert band/wind ensemble literature, orchestral transcriptions, military marches, jazz and pop arrangements, Broadway standards, and of course, patriotic music. The USAF Band of the Golden West commonly performs throughout the seven westernmost states of Arizona, California, Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, and Washington as well as for national and international audiences.

Averaging approximately 350 performances a year, the Band's mission is to **honor** our veterans and **inspire patriotism** to our audiences. The band is assigned to Air Mobility Command (AMC), which provides rapid global support by transporting equipment, supplies, and people anywhere in the world in less than 24 hours. AMC averages one departure every 2.8 minutes, 365 days a year. During the course of this concert, there will be roughly 35 AMC missions flown: **delivering hope, fueling the fight, and saving lives.**

At any given time, AMC tankers are supporting approximately 160 various fixed and rotary wing aircraft for AMC, Air Force Central Command (AFCENT), our sister services, and allied nation operations. There are 13,000 military members and civilians assigned to Travis AFB with 560 currently deployed, including eight members from the Band of the Golden West. The popular music ensemble "Galaxy" is deployed as the AFCENT Band, in support of DoD initiatives, international outreach and in support of coalition forces.



Captain Dustin M. Doyle is the Commander and Conductor of the United States Air Force Band of the Golden West, Travis AFB, California. He earned his commission from Officer Training School in July of 2009 at Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama and was assigned as the Deputy Commander to the Band of Mid-America at Scott Air Force Base, Illinois. In 2011 he became Flight Commander and Assistant Conductor for the United States Air Force Academy Band, Peterson AFB, Colorado.

Originally from Huntingtown, Maryland, Captain Doyle received his Bachelor's Degree in Music Education from the University of Maryland. He went on to complete his Master's Degree in Wind Conducting from The Peabody Institute of the Johns Hopkins University. Captain Doyle has toured across the United States and through Europe, supporting Air Force Public Affairs outreach. Additionally, Captain Doyle has deployed as the AFCENT Band Officer-in-Charge, traveling through 9 countries across the Middle East and Southwest Asia in efforts to build partnerships with our international allies and boost the morale of our coalition service members.
