TRUMPET AUDITION

Resumes and recordings must be delivered by May 1, 2016. Applicants who are considered qualified for the live audition will be contacted by the USAF Band auditions team and then by an Air Force recruiter to assess each applicant's eligibility to enlist in the Air Force. Once approved by the recruiter, applicants will receive an audition invitation letter. All invited candidates must be prepared to meet Air Force maximum allowable weight standards.

PRE-SCREENING REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

1. Resume
2. Audio recordings to include (please record in the following order):
 - One movement of a trumpet concerto or solo, applicant's choice, should be technical in nature (may be accompanied or unaccompanied)
 - Charlier Etude # 2, beginning through measure 24
 - Concert Band excerpt: *Summon the Heroes*, trumpet solo
 - Concert Band excerpt: *Festive Overture*, Trumpet 1, beginning through rehearsal number 4
 - Concert Band excerpt: *Festive Overture*, Trumpet 4, pickup to rehearsal number 6 through rehearsal number 7
3. **Optional:** Applicants may submit additional lead or jazz improvisation tracks to display commercial skills
