Captain Rafael F. Toro-Quinones is the Commander and Conductor of the United States Air Force Band of the Golden West, Travis Air Force Base, California. The only active duty Air Force Band west of the Rocky Mountains, this 60-member musical unit is comprised of eight different performing groups that honor heritage, inspire trust, and connect people across 727,000 square miles throughout its 7-state area of responsibility, averaging over 360 performances each year, promoting the excellence of Air Mobility Command and the United States Air Force.

Captain Toro-Quinones entered the Air Force in 1997 as an enlisted member of the USAF Band of Mid-America, Scott AFB, Illinois. As a bassist, he held subsequent assignments in the USAFE Band, Sembach Air Base, Germany and the USAF Band of Liberty, Hanscom AFB, Massachusetts. In 2007 he was accepted to the prestigious New England Conservatory of Music where he earned a Master of Music Degree in Wind Ensemble Conducting with academic honors.

After winning a band officer audition, he received his Air Force commission through the Officer Training School at Maxwell, AFB, Alabama and in 2009 was assigned to the USAF Heritage of America Band, Langley, Virginia as the Deputy Commander. Additionally, Captain Toro-Quinones has been the Commander and Conductor of the USAF Heartland of America Band, Offutt AFB, Nebraska, and of the USAF Band of the West, Lackland AFB, Texas. In February 2013 he completed a six month deployment as the Officer in Charge of the U.S. Air Forces Central Command Band.

Captain Toro-Quinones is a native of San Juan, Puerto Rico. He holds an undergraduate degree in bass performance and philosophy from DePauw University, Greencastle, Indiana. He has worked as a freelance musician in Puerto Rico, the United States and Europe. He has performed with the San Juan Pops and recorded with the famous Puerto Rican music group Hacienda Punto en Otro Son. His conducting teachers include Charles Peltz and William Drury.
